INVASIVE PROBLEM PLANT CONTROL

FroK, representing the community, has been allocated 3 EPWP workers to work on invasive problem plant control every day of the week, for six months with us, as from Monday 7th January 2019.

The idea is that we educate the workers on Alien Invasive Plant identification and then how to remove them.

The recent rains has made it ideal to remove the problem plants before seeding and break off the new shoots of trees which were cut down last year to combat bush encroachment. Our team has also been supplemented by two new nature conservation graduates, and at times Joburg at Work workers have joined us too.

We have asked the workers to put the seeds in garbage bags, and dig or pull out the problem plants and leave some of them visibly next to the path so that the hikers can learn which the problem plants are.
