The Witwatersrand – The worlds Greatest Goldfield

Rod Tucker will be talking on the full history of gold in the Witwatersrand, from the stars to the different gold deposits in the Witwatersrand. Last year I found that Rod is first author of the wide-ranging paper "A Review of the Witwatersrand Basin - The World's Greatest Goldfield, Rodney F. Tucker, Richard P. Viljoen and Morris J. Viljoen". I approached Rod last year to get us up to date on the geological history of the Witwatersrand, including the gold mined at the Struben Mine in the Reserve. This talk is his second on the topic and also goes into astrophysics to explain how gold came to be in the universe and therefore in the earth.
