- Not good things we need an action plan: dogs getting into the reserve and killing buck and other game, squatting, poaching, bush encroachment - the natural veld, mostly grassland, is being replaced by bush, with subsequent insufficient food for mountain reedbuck in the reserve; fire management; alien and invasive plant control; breaking of public-open spaces bylaws: alcohol and electronic music spoiling the ambiance of the reserve; cricket and adult soccer games on amphitheatre lawn

Snare Hunt, Saturday 19th August

Meeting at the Kloofendal Ecological Centre attended by 12 people, it was good, luckily no snares were found! Danie Pretorius organized a follow up on Saturday 23rd August. One of the participants brought a whole lot of snares she had picked up on the local ridge (not in Kloofendal) when she walks her dog there. The snares are on display in the Ecological Centre, they are made up of strong, thin wire nooses, and the wire looks as if it comes from bicycle gearing. Snare patrol and fence patrols will be discussed at the AGM.
